In line with our Positive Fashion initiative, the British Fashion Council is committed to helping create an industry that drives forward best practice behaviours and supports an inclusive, diverse and sustainable fashion industry.

Please find below the Student Placement Learning Agreement which has been developed with members of the BFC Colleges Council and legal guidance. Student placements are compulsory for individuals who must complete a sandwich year as part of their undergraduate study. Since placements are integral to a student's degree, the focus must be on education and training as defined by the law. Adherence to this will also help safeguard a future thriving workforce for the industry.

When appointing a student placement into a designer business or brand, universities and placement providers should use this document to agree on expected codes of practice for the duration of a student's placement. The BFC recommends that this agreement be used in conjunction with the Best Practice Guide for Industry.

- 3. It is understood that the Company has arranged for Public Liability and Employers Liability insurance cover (Insurance Indemnity), and that the policy includes cover for persons under work experience schemes.
- 4. During the placement, the student is bound to the host company's regulations. The student will agree not to use, in any case, the information used for their placement portfolio for the benefit of other parties or publication, without the agreement of the Company.
- 5. In case of a breach of discipline, the Company reserves the right to end the placement period after prior notification to the university representative.
- 6. At the end of the placement, the Company will give the student a certificate or letter précising the nature and duration of the placement, which could act as reference letter.
