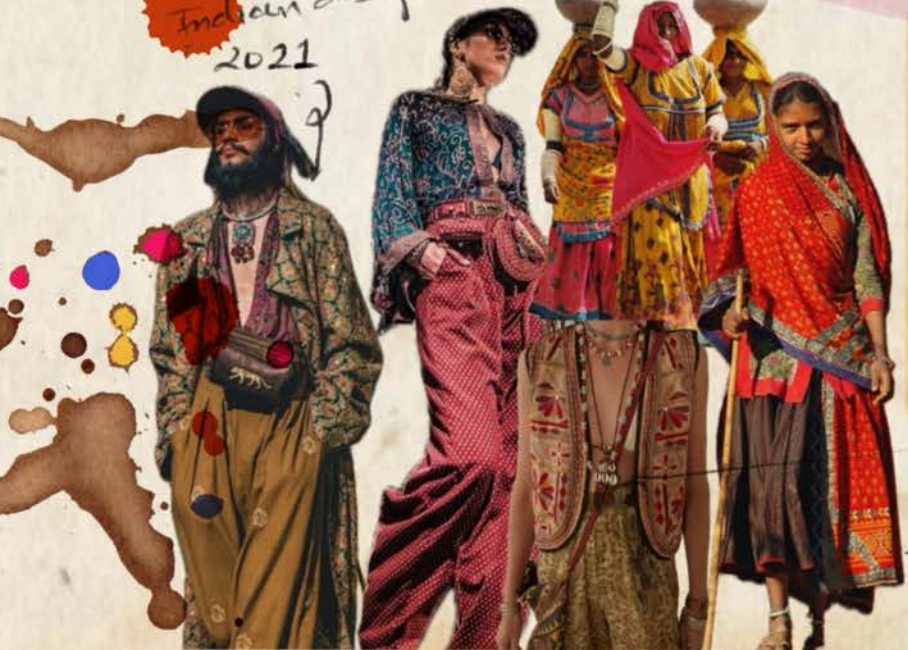

While taking blessings from deity in a temple, I was looking at a traditional clothing items.



This outfit is inspired by the village of Gujarat and my grandfather, who was a landowner and agriculture farmer. In my village, this outfit is predominantly worn by men casually. It draws inspiration from the diversity and colonialism in India known as "surwar" and "kediya," with a scarf called "khes." The turban serves as protection against the wind and sun, and it can also be used as a piece of fabric for taking a nap.

"I'm not satisfied with the result, so I've decided not to use this shirt in the final layout. Instead, I've created a pattern from it, focusing on just the shape to generate random similar shapes. This way, I can layer it over the design."

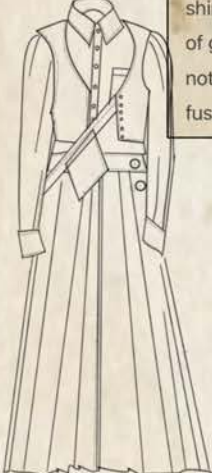

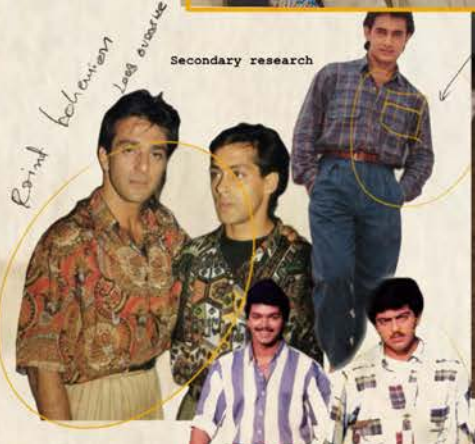

Dyeing and tie-dyeing



Inspiration draws from ancient Indian dyeing techniques, which I explore through the art of tea and coffee staining. My journey began with thorough research into fabric dyeing methods. Initially, I experimented with samples to achieve a commercial aesthetic. Here, I present my process for dyeing fabrics, blending tradition with modern innovation to create unique and captivating designs.

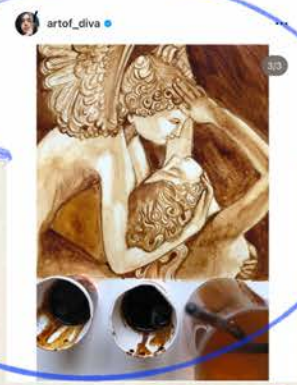
Ingredients:

- Tea bags or loose tea leaves
- Water
- Textile to be dyed

Instructions:

1. Boil water and steep tea bags or leaves for 30 minutes to 1 hour.
2. Prepare textile by washing and rinsing.
3. Remove tea bags or strain leaves from the tea solution.
4. Submerge textile in the tea solution for 1-2 hours.
5. Rinse textile under cold water until water runs clear.
6. Hang textile to dry in a well-ventilated area.
7. Once dry, your tea-dyed textile is ready to use!

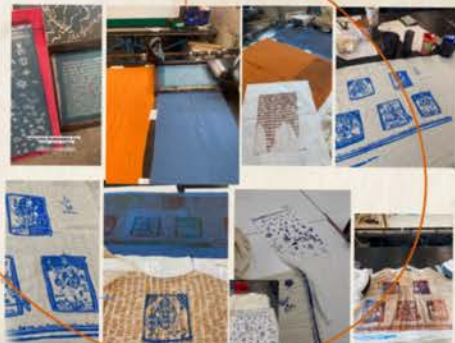
Embracing sustainability in every aspect of my craft, I explore innovative methods such as creating biodegradable ink from tea. This eco-conscious approach aligns with my commitment to reducing environmental impact while infusing my designs with a unique, earthy aesthetic. By harnessing the natural properties of tea, I transform it into a versatile medium for artistic expression, adding depth and character to my fashion portfolio.



Musicians and painters, known as chitrakars, moved from village to village to tell the villagers the stories of Hindu mythology. They illustrated their accounts using large bolts of canvas painted on the spot with simple means and dyes extracted from plants. Similarly, the ones found in Hindu temples are large panels of Kalamkari depicting the episodes of Hindu mythology and iconography, similar to Buddhist Thangka paintings. The Muslims who patronized this craft in the Coromandel and Goiconda province called the practitioners of this craft "Qalamkars", from which the term "Kalamkari" evolved. The Pedana Kalamkari craft made in Pedana nearby Machilipatnam in Krishna Andhra Pradesh, evolved under the patronage of the Muslims and the Goiconda sultanate. Owing to the said patronage, this school was influenced by Persian art under Islamic rule. Kalamkari art has been practiced by many families in Andhra Pradesh, some villages in Tamil Nadu (Chikankanjikampall) by migrants from Telugu speaking families over the generations have constituted their livelihood. Kalamkari had a period of decline, then was revived in India and abroad for its craftsmanship. Since the 18th century, the British have enjoyed the decorative element for clothing.

Kalamkari is a type of hand-painted cotton textile produced in the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh. Only natural dyes are used in Kalamkari, which involves twenty-three steps. There are two distinctive styles of Kalamkari art in India - Machilipatnam style and Srikalahasti style.

I used a baby lock for the seam joint, incorporating four pattern pieces: a hood, a draped neckline, and a single long sleeve designed to create a dramatic, crisis neckline effect. The shoulder pieces are attached together to evoke the draped look of a saree.

For the waistcoat, I repurposed leftover denim fabric, ensuring it fits snugly as a crop waistcoat. My aim was to create a versatile piece that pairs seamlessly with crop tops, offering a perfect casual silhouette that's comfortable for walking and various activities. To achieve this, I incorporated triangular cuts, or "nachos," on both the front and back, enhancing the fitting over the bust and back curve.

For the skirt, I utilized a long rectangle piece, extending from the waist to the hips, with a cross edge, creating an umbrella-like silhouette. I incorporated extra fabric to allow for pleating, resulting in pleats twice the length of the waist. Employing a baby lock technique, I enhanced the garment's crisis look while ensuring a flowing drape using thin, organic cotton fabric.

Adding a waist belt on the side and a zip for access from the hips, I secured the waist belt with wooden buttons on the edges for an ideal fit. To enhance the look, I incorporated extra length on the lower portion to create a dhoti-inspired aesthetic, offering both style and comfort.

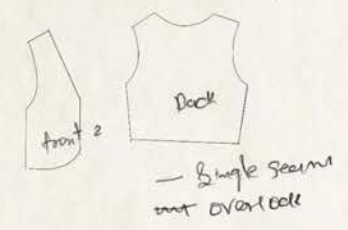
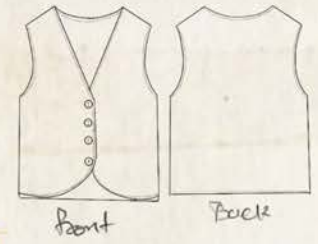

01 I crafted a waistcoat using hemp material, attaching it with a single French seam and overlocking the edges for durability. Omitting nachos, I focused on providing unrestricted access to the fabric. To enhance the organic aesthetic, I adorned it with crafted wooden buttons and added rounded edges for comfort. Incorporating a lining only in the front section, I aimed to maximize comfort without compromising on the garment's natural feel.

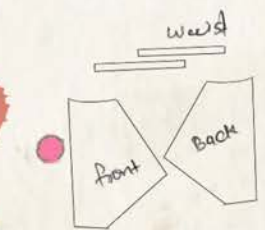

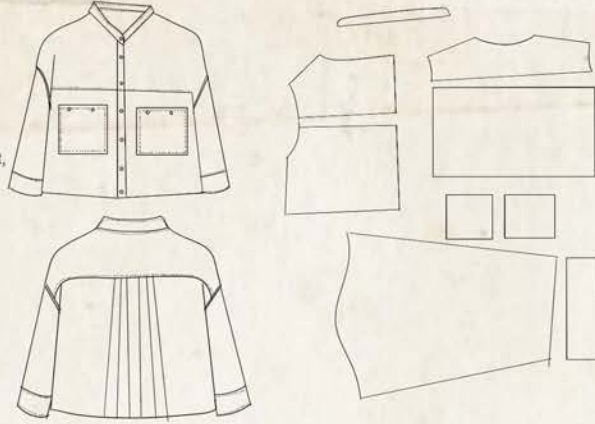

I crafted a stand collar shirt using French seams for durability and overlocking on the edges to reinforce the construction. Pleats on the back provide added comfort, while the sleeves are finished with attached hems and French seams for a polished look. Incorporating two large pockets, I adorned the shirt with wooden crafted buttons to enhance its organic aesthetic.

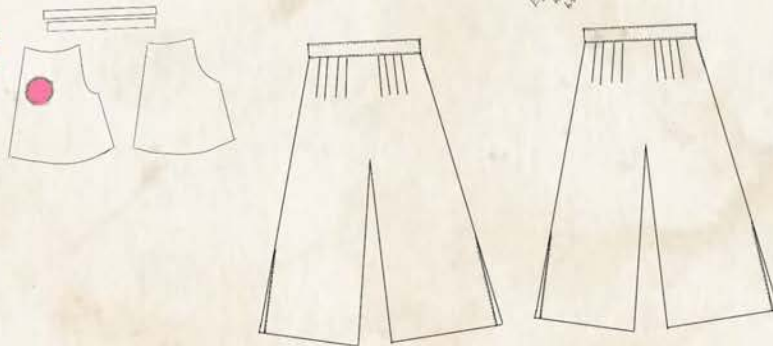
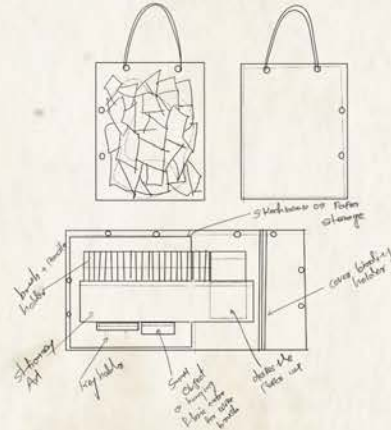

This tote bag serves as a versatile storage solution for art supplies and travel essentials. Designed to accommodate various small stationary items, it features a sturdy canvas lining for added durability. Utilizing overlock, eyelets, and single seams, I ensured robust construction throughout. To minimize waste, I repurposed leftover fabric for the exterior, reserving canvas from previous projects for the lining.

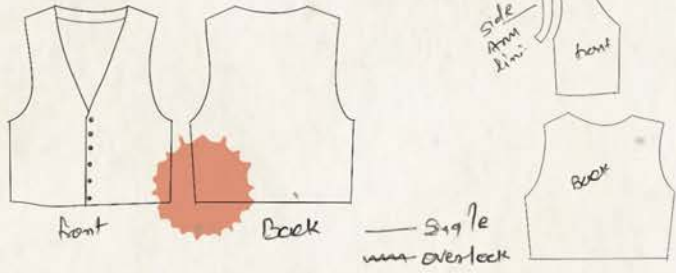
Crafting wide-leg pants to achieve a pleated look on both the front and back, I opted for a size three sizes larger than standard straight pants. To enhance comfort during yoga and meditation, I incorporated ankle cuts. Providing easy access, I added a zip with a wooden button at the edge for waist fitting. Utilizing overlock and French single seam techniques throughout, I ensured both durability and a polished finish.

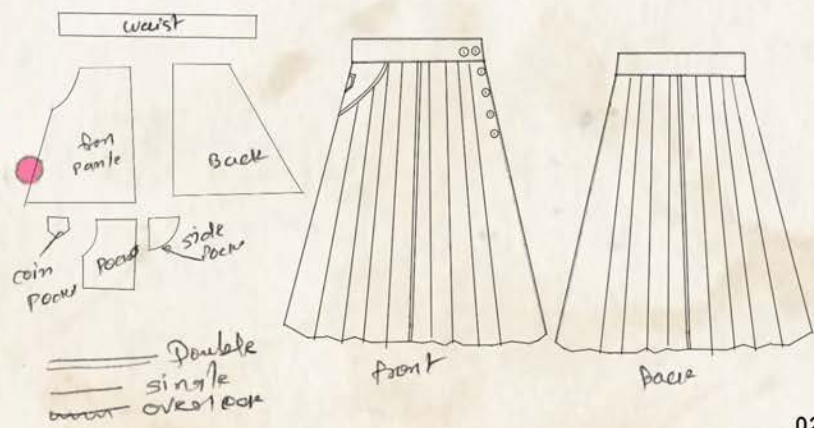
I crafted this shirt with an attached belt featuring a pocket, employing various techniques to ensure impeccable construction. For the collar and stand collar, I utilized reverse French seams to achieve a polished finish. Similarly, on the sleeves and shirt edges, I employed reverse seams and single seams with overlocking for durability. Adding to the aesthetic, I incorporated buttonholes and hand-stitched wooden buttons, enhancing both functionality and style.

For this waistcoat, I utilized a simple block pattern to ensure flexibility. I attached the front and back pieces from the shoulders with a single stitch, followed by overlocking the edges. Incorporating a cotton lining in the front, I secured it with a reverse stitch and then attached it to the sides using a combination of overlocking and French seams. Finally, I added wooden buttons at the last step, providing a rustic yet stylish finishing touch to the waistcoat.






For this denim skirt, I employed double seams and overlocking to enhance its durability, considering the thicker fabric. Initially, I stitched a single seam for stability, followed by a double seam for reinforcement. Perfecting the pleats with single seams, I then attached them to the waist belt. Adding wooden buttons at the side provided both functionality and a touch of rustic charm.

After finishing the sewing process, I tie up the top in Look 5 using ancient techniques, infusing it with the charm of a DIY approach, inspired by natural organic indigo.



For Look 5, I'm crafting two crop tops inspired by the pleated techniques of the chaniya and kediyā. Incorporating rounded cuts and strategic pleating, I'm ensuring ample bust size access while infusing the essence of traditional craftsmanship.

In Look 3, I'm focusing on enhancing back coverage by adjusting the pattern layout to provide more bust access in the front. Embellishments such as extra buttons add a touch of artisanal charm, while a fabric belt attached at the back offers a stylish tie detail at the front neckline.

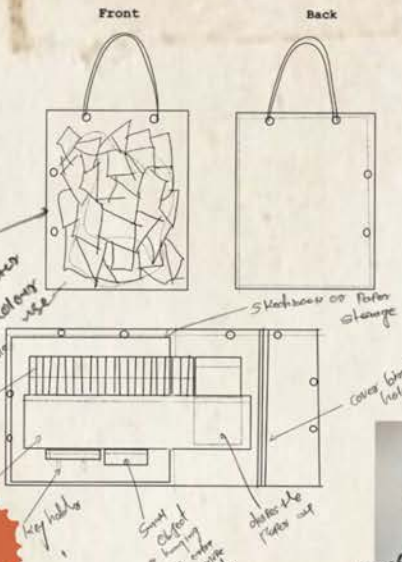

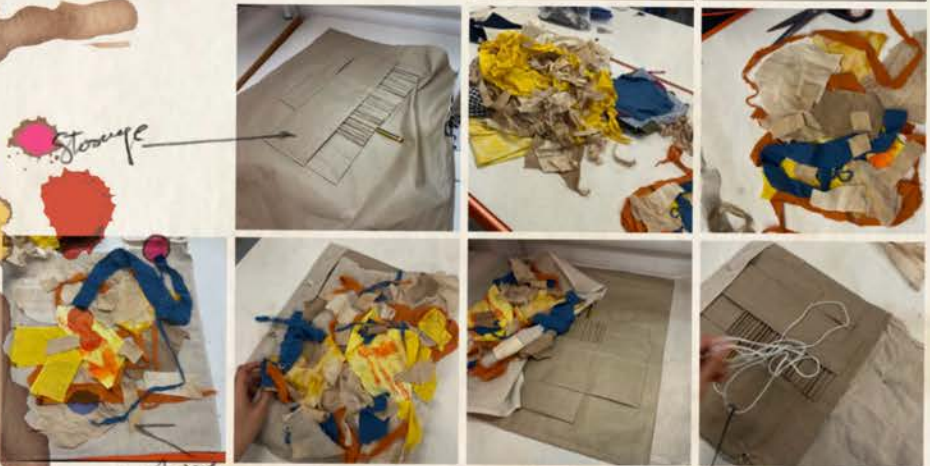
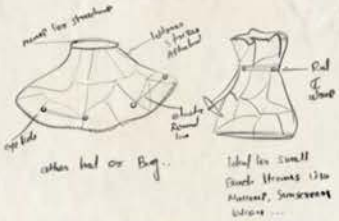
