

Periodical Panic is a Fashion knitwear collection exploring the emotional response to bad news. It is a powerful expression of the emotional turmoil stirred by current events, turning anxiety into fashion fabrics and garments. My inspiration was newspapers' physical properties, such as colour, weight, and form. The project captures the essence of panic and anxiety sparked by reading newspapers, translating these emotions into bold designs. It utilizes a palette of paperwhites, greys, and ominous blacks with a splash of scarlet within patterns and motives inspired by distorted typography.







GATHERED JUMPER DEVELOPMENT



Look 1- Jumper

Garment Descriptions:

Oversized asymmetric jumper with double collar neckline. Full left sleeve finished in open-ended 1 by 1 trim. Cut out arm whole on left side finished in the same trim with mitred v shape. Wide round neck with outer collar matching cuffs and inner roll neck in 1 by 1 trim. Double layer construction with inner fitted 5g half milano base and oversized $\frac{1}{2}$ 2.5 half cardigan and 1 by 1 striped outer layer. Joined with over locking at the sleeve head and caught in trim linking in other seams. The outer fabric has been gathered by hand and stitched in place with a latch needle.

Linker 3 point (6 point using every other needle) Over locker


Sustainability points:


Positives-The garment uses natura fibres from dead stock yarn preventing the production of new fibres and not adding to the demand for synthetic fibres. The fabric was particularly fashioned with only the neck and sleeve shaping on the inner layer being cut and sew. This has saved the wasting of excess material. The garment has no hard fastenings and would fully biodegrade in time.

Negatives- The jumper is extremely oversized and uses a huge amount of yarn to produce.
