

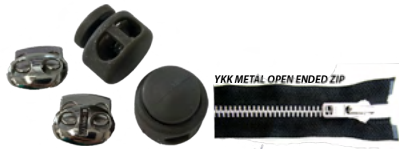
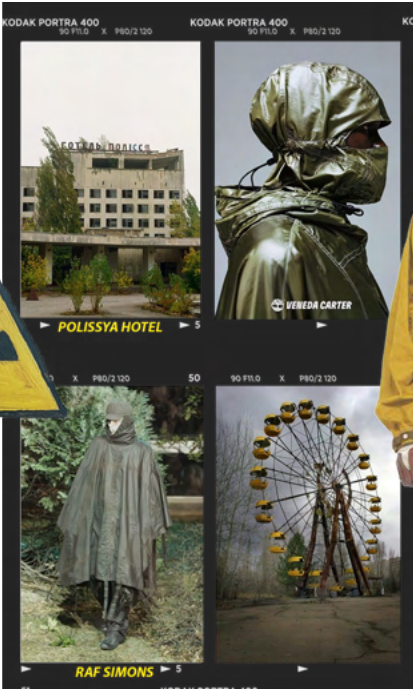
CHERNOBYL THE LIQUIDATORS
