Lichens and Tents:
Bio-fabrication and Deadstock

My concept is 'Intimate Nature', its purpose is to highlight the importance of biofabrication from microorganisms, 'Lichens', and their role in the sustainability of textiles and fashion in the future, with the circularity of using Dead-stock materials. This is a key part of my ethos as a designer.

I used the captivating shapes, textures and colours of the 'Lichens' to create Twill relief Jacquard Knit (Stool Machine), domestic knit, patterned fabrics/ garments. I also used surplus tents and parachute remnants from Raeburn, London, create Lichen and tent-like sculptural garments, influenced by waste conscious pattern cutting.
