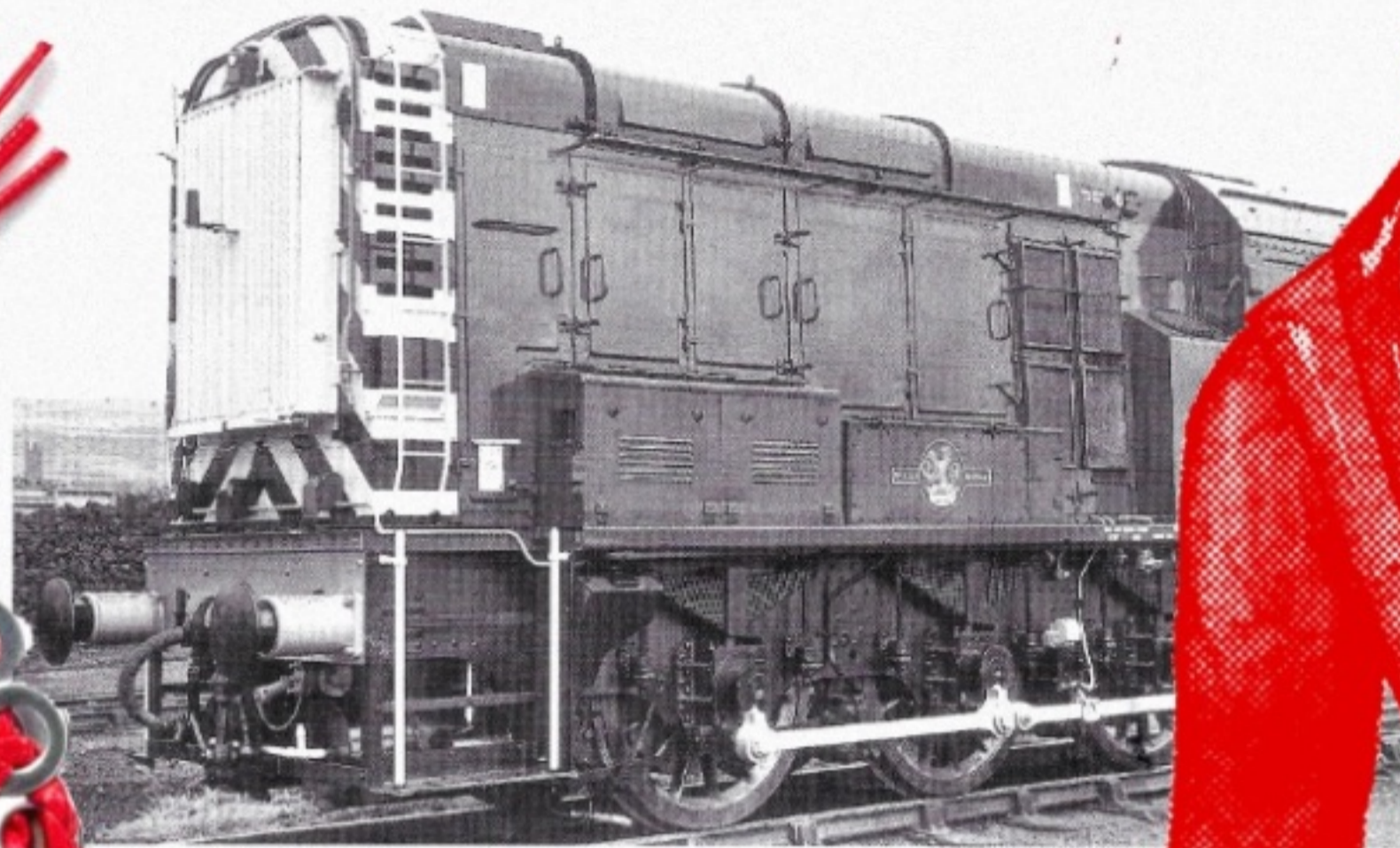




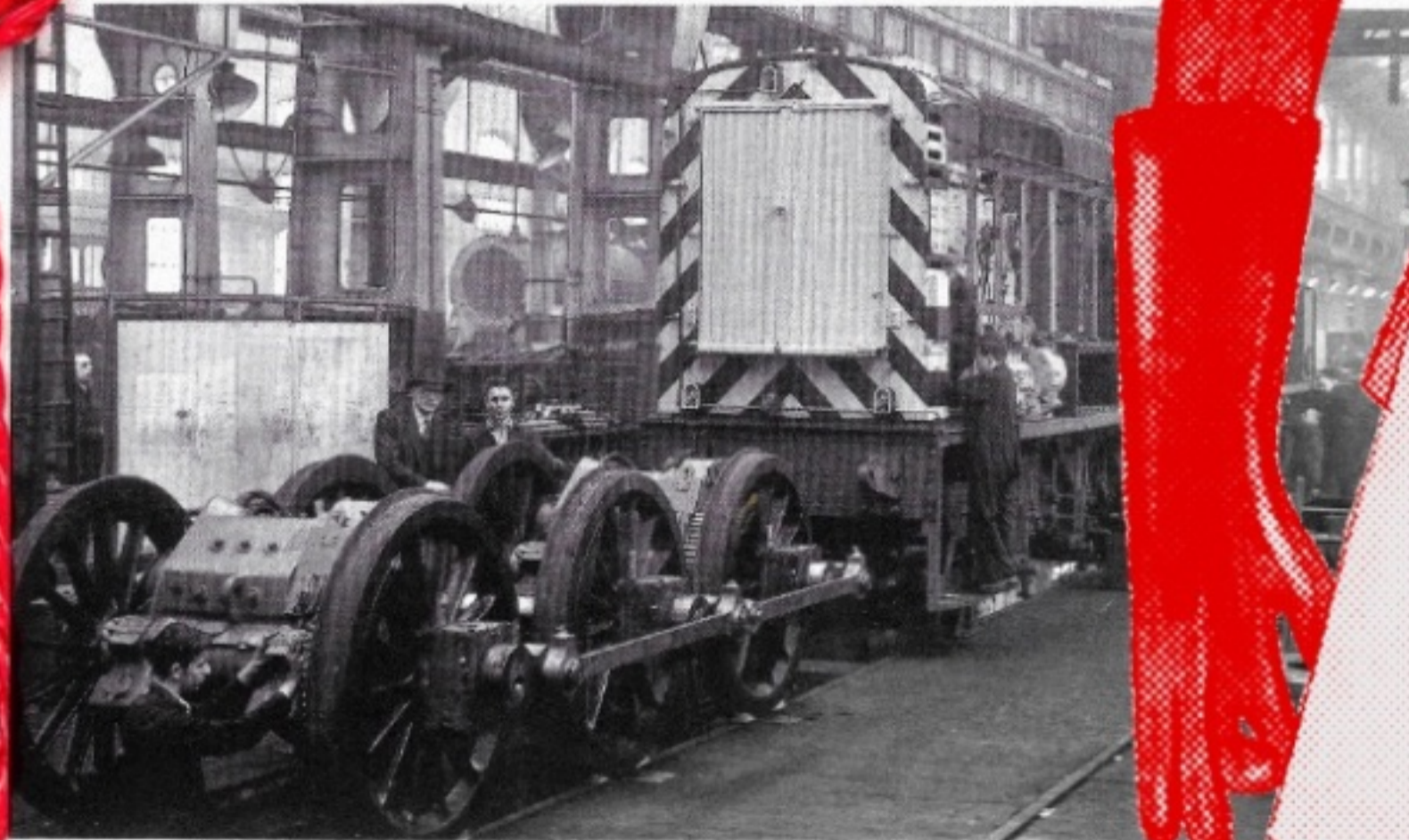


On the 20th August 1958, Horwich Locomotive Works began the construction of a series of 350 horse power 0-6-0 diesel shunting locomotives. The rate of build for these locomotives was one every 21 working days. The

first to leave the works was numbered D. 3593 and on the 28th December 1962 a total of 169 diesel locomotives were manufactured at Horwich. The last one to leave the works was numbered 4157.
